

- ii. Refresh our Local Plan by 2018 to deliver the required housing, employment space and infrastructure to meet the future economic needs of the area up to 2036 whilst maintaining the character of the Borough.
- iii. Regenerate town centres across the Borough (where appropriate) to bring forward retail, office accommodation, leisure and entertainment facilities, as well as housing.

- vi. Support all businesses including start-ups to grow by partnering with the Business Growth Hub.

## Objective 3: Ensure that people have the skills that businesses need and are able to support themselves into employment

- i. Work in partnership with TVB LEP to identify the skills needs of businesses and support the Strategic Skills statement.
- ii. Realise the potential of all young people, including reducing the number who are NEET (not in employment, education or training) by brokering with employers, schools and colleges.
- iii. Value and harness the skills and experience of older workers across Wokingham Borough in partnership with organisations such as the Wokingham Skills and Economy Group.
- iv. Promote STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) subjects and careers in all schools and colleges.
- v. Maximise the career opportunities in construction generated through the growth across the Borough.
- vi. Support all vulnerable people into employment and as a corporate parent, ensure that our children in care and care leavers are given the best possible opportunities to engage with the workplace.
- vii. Promote apprenticeships as a viable career path for young people.

## Objective 4 : Encourage innovation and technology to build a competitive business environment

- i. Improve broadband connectivity and speeds so that 99.5% of properties in the Borough have access to superfast coverage
- ii. Make use of the 'internet of things' across Council services; transport, healthcare, energy. The 'internet of things' is the network of physical objects embedded with technology to communicate, sense or interact with each other or the external environment.

#### **Subject: Wokingham Borough Council's Gypsy and Traveller Local Plan (GTLP)**

Dear Sir or Madam

You are being contacted as you have previously been consulted on Wokingham Borough Council's Gypsy and Traveller Local Plan (GTLP) and/or have submitted comments to the Council. Firstly, thank you for any comments submitted. Your response was appreciated and the Council has fully considered your comments.

Secondly, the Council is currently preparing a Local Plan Update to 2036. As many of the processes to be followed to produce both the GTLP and Local Plan Update are similar, these can be combined. Combining the GTLP into the Local Plan Update will ensure that traveller provision is treated similarly to housing provision as per National Government's aims that there is consistency in plan periods for both traveller and housing provision while also allowing for changes in national 'Planning Policy for traveller sites' to be incorporated. Combining the two plans will have the effect of aligning the plan period for the GTLP work with the Local Plan update so that the needs of travellers will be planned for over a longer period (to 2036) rather than 2029 as was previously proposed with the GTLP. It will additionally ensure that sites are phased appropriately and will allow for more efficient plan making process through a single examination of the Local Plan Update.

The GTLP Working Group have therefore agreed to incorporate the GTLP into the Local Plan Update. The work completed to date will be used to support the Local Plan Update and therefore has not been wasted. Again, the Council values your comments and will continue to consider these in developing policies for the Local Plan Update. There will be further opportunity to comment on the overall approach to Gypsy and Traveller provision as part of the Local Plan Update process. The timescales for preparing the Local Plan are set out in the Council's Local Development Scheme found here.
