Budget engagement sessions: Learn more about our financial position and challenges we face

For the second year running, and building on from what we did last year, Wokingham Borough Council is launching its budget engagement sessions in October.

Taking place in five locations in the Borough, local people will be able to hear more about the serious funding challenges and shrinking budgets facing the council. It has to save almost £19million by 2019/20 despite responding effectively to austerity and funding cuts from central government since 2010.

Attendees will be able to talk to councillors and staff from all borough council service areas and take part in the 'Funding Priorities Dilemma' activity. People will also be able to complete a survey to tell the council what they think about the principles used by the borough council to set a budget. This will also be available online from 17 October so that anyone not able to get along to the session can also take part.
